NOTICE OF RACE

Ammended April 5, 2024

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in [The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024](#), subject to alteration by [PHRF-BC](#), the sailing instructions and notification from the race committee.
- 1.2. All boats must comply with the Safety Requirements as set out in the [2022 SER Nearshore Category](#) as well as the [Transport Canada Small Vessel Requirements](#) applicable to them.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats with a valid PHRF-BC certificate and proof of insurance that meet all requirements as stated in the NOR and Sailing Instructions.
- 3.2 Boats without a valid PHRF-BC certificate are welcome to attend and will be assigned a rating by the Fleet Captain.

4. REGISTRATION & FEES

- 4.1 Early Registration prior to midnight March 31st: TCYC Members \$20 – Non-Members \$25
 - 4.1.1 Late registration April 1st to April 12th: TCYC members: \$25.00 Non-members: \$35.00.
- 4.2 Competitors must register at www.tiddlycove.bc.ca prior to racing. Boats that fail to register and pay by 20:00 of the day prior to racing may not be scored.

5. CLASSES and CLASS FLAGS

- 5.1. Boats will be divided into two divisions based on their PHRF Rating. If a boat has a PHRF rating faster (lower) than 134 then she is in Division 1, otherwise she is in Division 2.
- 5.2. Boats may request assignment to a different division by making a request in writing to the TCYC Fleet Captain prior to racing in the series.

5.3. Class flags will be:

Division	Flag
1	1
2	2

5.4. No Flying Sails. Boats rated for spinnaker but wish to race no flying sails shall make this clear to the race committee at check-in.

5.4.1. Any boat declaring no flying sails will be scored in the division appropriate to its usual PHRF rating.

5.4.2. The no flying sails allowance is based on a valid PHRF certificate removing the spinnaker codes and adjustments.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available by 10:00 on the day before the race at www.tiddlycove.bc.ca.

Competitors participate in the race entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority and TCYC will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the race.

9. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.
