1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in [The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013 – 2016](#) with all prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association, the rules of [PHRF-BC](#), the [VARC NOR](#), the rules for ORC club, the Farr 30 International One Design Class Rules, and the Martin 242 Class Rules as amended by Fleet One, .the sailing instructions and notification from the race committee.
- 1.2 All boats must comply with [PIYA 2013 Catagory III](#).

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats with a valid PHRF-BC certificate and proof of insurance that meet all requirements as stated in the NOR and Sailing Instructions.
- 3.2 Boats without a valid PHRF-BC certificate are welcome to attend and will be assigned a rating by the Fleet Captain.

4 REGISTRATION & FEES

- 4.1 TCYC members: \$45.00. Non-members: \$50.
- 4.2 Competitors must register at www.tiddlycove.bc.ca, or the VARC web site prior to racing. Boats that fail to register and pay by 2300 of the day prior to the regatta will not be scored.

- 5.2 Deadline for registration and payment: 2300 Friday, August 15.

- 5.4 Party at Kitsilano Yacht Club: 1700 to 2300, Saturday, August 16.
