NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in [The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020](#), the Sail Canada national prescriptions, the Notice of Race, the Rules of [PHRF-BC](#), and PHRF-NW, the Farr 30 International One Design Class Rules, the rules for ORC Club the Martin 242 Class Rules as amended by Fleet One, the rules of the [VARC NOR](#), the Sailing Instructions and any subsequent amendments, and notification from the Race Committee.
- 1.2** All boats must comply with Transport Canada and Canadian Coast Guard regulations, and [Pacific International Yachting Association \(PIYA\) Safety Equipment Requirements \(SER\) Category Nearshore](#) or [ISAF Off Shore Regulations Category 4](#), as amended in the [VARC Notice of Race 1.5.4](#).
- 1.3** A yacht that impedes or obstructs commercial traffic may be subject to disqualification. A yacht that is the subject of five horns from commercial traffic may be subject to protest and disqualification.
- 1.4** Competitors who intend to fly sails that display numbers other than the yacht's official sail number shall report those numbers to the Race Committee (RC) by email at <mailto:fleetcaptaintcyc@gmail.com> at or before 1300 hours Friday, August 18, 2017. Failure to comply may be subject to protest by the Race Committee.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1** Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1** The regatta is open to all boats with a valid PHRF-BC certificate and proof of insurance that meet all requirements as stated in the NOR and Sailing Instructions.
- 3.2** Boats without a valid PHRF-BC certificate are welcome to attend and will be assigned a rating by the Fleet Captain.

4 REGISTRATION & FEES

- 4.1** **Early registration** TCYC members: \$55.00. Non-members: \$65. After 24:00 on August 6 a \$10 additional fee applies. Late registration after August 17 is \$90. These rates include the Skipper's dinner and beverage. Additional meals can be purchased at registration for \$20 (below cost and subsidised by Karen Weiner, TAC Realty).
- 4.2** Competitors must register at www.tiddlycove.bc.ca prior to racing. Boats that fail to register and pay by 19:00 of the day prior to the regatta will not be scored.

5 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 5.1** Last chance to register: 1900 Friday, August 18. ALL PAYMENTS TO BE MADE ON LINE.
- 5.2** Deadline for registration and payment: 2000 Friday, August 18.
- 5.3** 5 minute warning signal for all divisions: 1055 Saturday, August 19.
- 5.4** Party at Vancouver Maritime Museum: 1700 to 2300, Saturday, August 19.

The sailing instructions will be available by 1000 on the day prior to the regatta at www.tiddlycove.bc.ca.

7 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows: To the top 3 boats in VARC divisions 1, 2, 3, 7, and M242 as well as overall PHRF, present at party at the Vancouver Maritime Museum.

The organizing authority and TCYC will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
