NOTICE OF RACE

With Amendment #1 – August 7, 2019 (changes in green)

1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in [The Racing Rules of Sailing](#).

1.2 The regatta will be governed by the VARC Notice of Race 2019, portions of which are referenced within this notice of Race for clarity.

1.3 Class Rules

1.3.1 ORC Rating System Rules will apply to all boats racing under an ORC handicap.

1.3.2 PHRF BC Rules will apply to all boats racing under a PHRF handicap. Boats that do not possess a PHRF BC rating certificate, or possess a rating certificate from a ratings jurisdiction other than PHRF BC, will receive a club rating from the Club's handicapper.

1.3.3 Martin 242s shall race in PHRF configuration (including engines on). Martins will be scored as a single class on Saturday and will be joining Division 3 on Sunday under rules of PHRF BC.

1.4 Boats that intend to fly sails that display numbers other than her official sail number shall report those numbers to the race committee by email at fleetcaptaintcyc@gmail.com at or before 1300 hours Friday, August 9, 2019. Boats who fail to comply may be subject to protest by the race committee.

1.5 All boats must comply with the Safety Requirements as set out in section 1.5 of the 2019 VARC Notice of Race found [here](#).

1.6 A yacht that impedes or obstructs commercial traffic may be subject to disqualification. A yacht that is the subject of five horns from commercial traffic may be subject to protest and disqualification.

1.7 Competitors who intend to fly sails that display numbers other than the yacht's official sail number shall report those numbers to the Race Committee (RC) by email at fleetcaptaintcyc@gmail.com at or before 1300 hours Friday, August 9, 2019. Failure to comply may be subject to protest by the Race Committee.

2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to all boats belonging to an accredited yacht club (as set out in RRS 75.1), possessing a valid ORC, PHRF-BC, or PHRF-NW certificate for 2019, proof of insurance, that meets all requirements as stated in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions. Ratings will be adjusted if required by Tiddly Cove Yacht Club's handicapper in order to align PHRF-BC and PHRF-NW ratings.

- 3.2 A Yacht that that does not possess a valid PHRF-BC or PHRF-NW certificate will be assigned a courtesy rating by the Tiddly Cove Yacht Club's handicapper. This rating cannot be appealed.
- 3.3 In the event that a yacht's rating has been changed after the entry has been accepted, the skipper is required to notify the Fleet Captain by email to: Fleetcaptaintcyc@gmail.com. No rating changes will be accepted after 1300 hours August 9, 2019. Failure to provide a valid and correct rating may result in protest by the Race Committee. In addition, all ratings are subject to review by the Race Committee.
- 3.4 For Yachts Racing Under an ORC Handicap:
- (a) All yachts shall have a valid ORC Club or ORCi Certificate.
 - (b) In the event that a yacht's rating has been changed by its National Rating Office or the central ORC Rating Office after the entry has been accepted the skipper is required to notify the Fleet Captain by email to: Fleetcaptaintcyc@gmail.com. No change in a yacht's Triple Number scoring coefficients will be permitted after 1300 hours August 9, 2019. All ratings will be verified against the ORC database. Yachts that do not have an active rating in the ORC by 1300 hours August 9, 2019 will not be scored.
 - (c) All ORC competitors are reminded that full compliance with the prescriptions of their ORC rating is required, including maximum crew weights. The Organizing Authority may schedule a crew weigh-in, or it may randomly audit crew weights in yachts that are racing.

4 REGISTRATION & FEES

- 4.1 **Early registration** TCYC members: \$65.00. Non-members: \$80. After 24:00 on August 4 late registration is \$85. ENGLISH BAY SCRAMBLE BBQ dinner on Saturday at the Kitsilano Yacht Club is available at \$25 for pre-purchase at registration and \$30 at the door (while supplies last) and beverage is \$5.
- 4.2 Competitors must register at www.tiddlycove.bc.ca prior to racing. Boats that fail to register and pay by 20:00 of the day prior to the regatta will not be scored.

7 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows: For both the English Bay Scramble Long Course Saturday and Short Course Sunday prizes awarded to the top 3 boats in VARC divisions 1, 2, 3, 7, and M242 as well as overall PHRF for the English Bay Scramble (EBS), present at post racing events daily. The EBS Weekend Regatta Trophy awarded Sunday and presented at the annual TCYC awards night to the weekend overall winner. Awards to the two runners up and top three finishers in each division. Ties will be broken by EBS overall results.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority and TCYC will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. 9 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$2,000,000 per incident or the equivalent. **Proof of insurance is required at registration.**

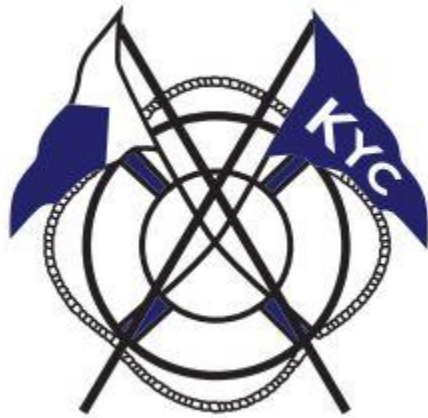
